Community Clinic, Inc. (CCI) provides important health care services for people who want to get and stay healthy. CCI welcomes new and

established patients at seven accessible locations in Prince George's and Montgomery counties. CCI offers a wide variety of primary care services; nutrition education and food supplements through the Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Program; and the new **Family Planning Program at Greenbelt.**

Community Clinic's Family Planning Program provides important services for women and men seeking quality family planning and other related care. If you want to be in control of your future and your plans to start or expand your family, CCI family planning can give you the medical attention and counseling you need.

The CCI Family Planning Program is committed to providing you information and resources to prevent unwanted and unplanned pregnancies. We offer supportive counseling, family planning care, preventive and preconception care. CCI also provides appropriate referrals.



CCI welcomes people in need of Family Planning services.

- Women, men and adolescents who are uninsured or under-uninsured
- Medicaid
- Medicare
- Homeless residents
- Persons who are disabled
- Persons encountering barriers to health care

What services are available?

- Pap smears
 - Birth control pills, vaginal ring, intrauterine devices, injection, etc.
 - Testing and treatment of most sexually transmitted infections
 - Preconception guidance and advice
 - Infertility counseling and referral
 - Preventative counseling that includes HIV/AIDS, sexually transmitted infections, sexual coercion, abstinence, etc.
 - Risk appropriate referrals for acute and chronic care, depression, domestic violence, child abuse, etc.
- Termination services are not provided at this clinic.*

How do I receive Family Planning services?

Family planning services are primarily in CCI's Greenbelt clinic. Call 1-866-877-7258 and ask to make an appointment for family planning. The patient representative will ask if you have health insurance. If you don't have insurance, you can still receive medical care at the clinic. The patient representative will give you information about the CCI sliding scale of reduced fees for service. The patient representative will make the appointment for you, ask you to bring in some proof of income, and ask that you come 15 minutes early to fill out forms. If you need to cancel an appointment, please call 1-866-877-7258. You must contact us 24 hours in advance of a cancellation to let us know and to reschedule.

What if I need lab tests or a specialist?

There are reduced fees for lab tests performed on-site and those done at the laboratory. Referrals will be given for sonograms, colposcopy, infertility counseling, and other related specialists and services. Most of the outside testing and specialty referrals are at a reduced cost, but this is not a guarantee.

How do I pay for services?
